"Most of us own a vette because it is the best sports car in the world for \$50,000. But admit it, don't all of us wonder what it would be like to drive a Ferrari, Lamborghini, Mercedes McLaren, ford GT, Porsche GT 3, etc? Well, I got to drive all of those cars plus a Noble M400 last weekend.

A company called world class driving goes around the country and offers this opportunity in various states and locations. For \$1,300, you get to drive each car for about 30-45 minutes depending on how many people sign up for each session. Sounds like a lot of money but it's a once in a lifetime opportunity for most of us car nuts.

Each of these cars is a brand new 07 model. There are only 500 McLaren in the world. I did my drive in the mountains around big bear lake CA, which is about 2 hours east of LA.

Everything was first class--the cars, the instructors, and the amount of time we spent with each car. You are responsible for your own speeding tickets but there were plenty of opportunities to open it up and hit triple digit speeds. You have not lived as a car fan until you hear and feel a Ferrari F430 or a Lamborghini Gallardo accelerate at full throttle through the gears.

At the end of the day, we received some neat gifts including a disk with pictures from the day. I had to pinch myself several times to see if I was really dreaming or driving the ford GT and the Ferrari.
